Beginning in the present, with Esther relating the story to her grandson and friends, she tells how Hitler came to power in Germany and began persecuting Jews. And though her family made new friends in Amsterdam, where they thought they would be safe, the Nazis rounded up all of the Jews there as well. Esther, who was away from home and escaped into the countryside, was the only survivor. Dutch artist Eric Heuvel illustrates the story in detailed color panels. 62.
